Camp Discovery Rental Rules and Regulations

- A signed rental agreement and a deposit of 50% of total (Cleaning deposit is not a part of this total) anticipated rental fees due upon signing and returning the agreement. The date will only be confirmed upon the receiving of the agreement and the two (2) deposit checks. (Deposit is NOT refundable if booking is canceled). Remaining balance is due within seven (7) days prior to the event. Make Checks Payable to The Tennessee Jaycee Foundation.
- \$200.00 refundable cleaning deposit – To have deposit refunded, make sure the area your group is clean – check with caretaker for inspection.
- Facilities available to the group will be determined at time of inquiry.
- Renters are to furnish all personal items, bedding, and toiletries. Cleaning supplies will be furnished to your group. **It is important that all groups leave Camp Discovery clean and ready for the next group, as we have several weekends that are booked back to back.**
- Table covers, paper products, or food of any kind, will **NOT** be provided by Camp Discovery. All our kitchen items, such as silverware, cooking utensils, pots and pans can be used, but must be washed and put back in their proper location, with an inventory taken before and after your visit. All trash (liners will be provided) is to be bagged and left in the provided dumpster.
- Any agreement between any Cooks, Caterers, or Special Activities will be between the two parties, and all fees will be paid directly to outside vendors. Camp Discovery will not be a part of that agreement.
- Swimming Pool Lifeguards – (Applies only to August and September rentals only.) The pool is closed the remainder of the year to renters. Camp Discovery does not provide a lifeguard for either the pool or the lake, and will not be held accountable or liable for any accidents that may occur
SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.
- No pets, or firearms are permitted at Camp Discovery.
- No nails, screws, staples, or glue are NOT to be used anywhere on the grounds, buildings structures or landscape. Tape, string, ribbon, zip ties, etc., are permitted with all residue and pieces being removed at the end of your event.

- Your group will be fully responsible for the full replacement of any or all loss, damage, etc. to the kitchen utensils/dishes and other structures, and equipment at Camp Discovery.
- Before you leave, please walk through all used structures and grounds to assure all personal, decoration and catered items are removed. If it wasn't there when you arrive, please don't leave it there.
- Camp Discovery, the Tennessee Jaycee Foundation, the Tennessee Jaycees, or the Corp of Engineers are not responsible for any damage, injuries or liabilities on the grounds and water area of and surrounding Camp Discovery.
